Dear Legends Cars Competitor,

After a fun evening on Saturday night, January 24 at the Valencia Ballroom in York, where the champions were crowned and many others were recognized for their achievements from 2008, we can't wait for the beginning of the 2009 season.

Pre-Season Open Practice Nights - SSP will begin its pre-season with 2 Saturday open practice sessions for any type of racecar on Saturday, March 28 and Saturday, April 4. The gates will open at 3:30 p.m. with practice sessions rotating for each class from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The cost will be \$12.00 per pit pass (14 & older). There will be no per car charge or fees for grandstand admission.

Wednesday Night Test & Tune Sessions – There will be 14 Wednesday Night Test & Tune Practices scheduled throughout 2009 beginning Wednesday, April 8 open to any type of racecars. The cost is \$12.00 per person for pit passes and a \$20.00 fee for each racecar entering the pit area (\$32.00 per car & driver). Gates will open at 5:00 p.m. with open practice from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Mid Summer Vacation Break – From Sunday, July 5 to Thursday, July 16, there will be no racing scheduled at SSP. There will be no races scheduled during this time as our vacation plans have already been set. It is a time for all SSP competitors to take time off and regroup for the second half of the season.

No Increases for Pit & Grandstand Pricing for Race Events - Regular General Admission Grandstand ticket prices will be Adults (18-59) \$12.00; Young Adults (11-17); Senior Adults (60 & older) \$10.00; Children (10 & under) are free. Prices will vary for special events. Regular season pit pass prices are now \$22.00 with a reduced price of \$20.00 for all pit competitor license holders. Special events will be \$25.00 with a reduced price of \$22.00 for all pit competitor license holders.

Special Pricing for 2009 Regular Season Pit Pass Cards – For the second straight year, in order to help weekly supporters, SSP has announced that 50 season pit pass cards for all automobile race events at the "Big Track" from April 11 through September 19 (29 events) are on sale for just \$325.00 (a retail value of more than \$575). This pass will also be valid for general grandstand admission for the four AMA Motorcycle events scheduled for the season. This equates to approximately \$13.00 per automobile event (regular pit pass prices are \$22.00 - \$25.00). Persons interested in purchasing this special offer are encouraged to contact the speedway at (717) 292-1696 or email sspracing@hotmail.com as soon as possible to be added to the list of those who want the special pricing that is offered on a limited basis. Payment is required within 7 days of notifying the speedway for the annual pit passes. The pass is not valid for events at the "Outback Track" or for the Test & Tune Sessions held throughout the season. **Special offer ends March 16, 2009.**

Grandstand Season Passes - Are available for only \$195.00 (adults ages 18-59); \$165.00 (young adults ages 11-17 & seniors 60 and older) for all automobile and motorcycle events (29 events) at the "Big Track" from April 11 to September 19, 2009.

Repeat Fan Discount in 2009 – Once again, there will be a \$2.00 discount for each person with a ticket stub from the prior week's race event only (previous Saturday in most cases). Returning fans are encouraged to write their name, address and phone number on the back of the stub to be entered into special drawings at the end of the season for great prizes. **The Repeat Fan Discount is not valid for pit pass purchases.**

SSP Pit Competitor Licenses - Enclosed you will find a 2009 pit license application. Copies may be made for all of your owners and crewmembers that would like to have a 2009 pit competitor license.

There are MANY advantages for all competitors with an annual license. A driver with an annual pit competitor license will receive the "license discount" for pit passes during the points-earning season (\$2.00 off for regular shows and up to \$3.00 for higher priced special events) and will be eligible to earn all posted point funds and awards associated towards the regular season points championship. **If a driver decides to only purchase a temporary pit license each event, then they will have to pay the full pit price admission and they will not be eligible for any posted point funds and awards in the SSP Track Championships.**

Annual SSP Pit Competitor Licenses for Drivers will be \$75.00 if purchased before February 28, 2009 and \$85.00 if purchased on or after March 1, 2009. Drivers may purchase an annual license after the season has begun, however if they had already competed in races under a "temporary" status, then the points earned under this "temporary" status will not be credited to them for post season point funds and awards.

Discounts for Team Members - Owners and crewmembers with a pit competitor licenses for Crew will also receive the "license discount" for pit passes during the points-earning season (\$2.00 off for regular shows and up to \$3.00 for higher priced special events).

Free Pit Passes for all Non-Qualifiers – Any non-qualifier who starts the a qualifying heat race and fails to qualify for the feature in the Late Model, Street Stocks, Xtreme Stock Car and Legends Cars divisions during the regular season point events will receive a complimentary pit pass for the driver for the following week (or next race event for that division) during the regular season from April 11 through September 19. **The driver must possess a full annual SSP license in order to be eligible for the complimentary pit pass and pass is not transferable to another driver or to another week beyond the following week.**

SSP Implements Hometown Heroes Program for 2009 - For the upcoming season, the Susquehanna Speedway Park will implement a new program called "Hometown Heroes." On selected nights throughout the season, the Hometown Heroes Program will recognize

drivers from particular cities and towns throughout PA & MD. Before the races begin, the drivers will have the opportunity to display their cars and meet the fans at the front gate of the speedway. The drivers will also be interviewed during the night's racing program. All fans entering the speedway from that driver's hometown being honored will be admitted FREE to the grandstands by showing proper photo identification at the ticket booth. More towns will be added based on drivers with annual SSP licenses.

Standard Legends Cars Feature Purse – The standard Legends Cars feature will be 20 laps and the purse will be - 1) \$250; 2) \$150; 3) \$100; 4) \$90; 5) \$75; 6) \$70; 7) \$60; 8) \$50; 9) \$40; 10) \$30; 11-24) \$25.

2009 Legends Cars Point Fund – To be announced when available (Minimum by Division: Pro - 1) 2 season pit passes; 2-5) 1 season pit pass; Masters and Semi Pro 1-5) 1 season pass).

Eligibility for Season Ending Awards - Drivers will also have the opportunity to exchange their 2009 point fund earnings for a complimentary season pit pass for the 2010 season valued at more than \$575.00. In order to collect the point fund awards and honors at the season-ending awards ceremony, the **driver must compete in at least 75% of the events held** on the race schedule (rainouts are not included in the %). More prizes and awards may be announced as they become available.

Legends Cars Race Event Format – The Legends Cars competitors will compete in a single 20-lap feature with all divisions combined. Points will be awarded for the track championship by the division designated on their SSP track license application. There will be a Pro Champion, Masters Champion and Semi Pro Champion determined at the end of the season. For all non-qualifiers for the main feature, there will be a special 10-lap feature held for them at the end of the evening's racing events.

Rain dates - There will be no rain dates for cancelled Saturday events. A few "special" events will have rain dates as marked on the schedule or to be announced if needed.

SSP EBAY Store – SSP has opened a "new" EBAY Store with a link at www.sspracing.net. The store will feature both new and old items (both racing and non-racing).

Weekly email list – Every week during the season, we send out an email both before an event. The pre-event email includes the time schedule and order of events. Emails about postponements and cancellations are also sent out via email. If you are not on this list and would like to be added, please send an email to sspracing@hotmail.com.

SSP Competitor's Link Section Added to SSP Website - Let your fans know the latest info on your team! If you're a regular Late Model, Street Stock, Xtreme Stock Cars or other regular SSP series competitor and have a website, e-mail the link of your web site to our webmaster at tvr1@comcast.net, so we can include you in this section.

Track Rental for the "Big Track" and the "Outback Track" – The "Big track" and the "Outback track" are available for rent beginning March 1, 2008. The "Big Track" rental fee is \$1,400.00 for 4 hours and may be split between a maximum of five-(5) drivers/teams. Only one car is permitted on the track at a time. If an ambulance is requested, it is an additional \$75.00 per hour. For nighttime rentals at the "Big Track", an additional \$100.00 per hour will be charged for lights. The rental price for the "Outback Track" is \$400.00 for 4 hours during the day /\$500.00 at night and may be split between a maximum of five-(5) drivers/teams. To reserve either track, please call 717-292-1696. **If you reserve the track with a \$400 deposit before February 28, 2009 for any date after March 1, we will reduce the "Big Track" rental price to \$1,200 (save \$200).**

Raceceivers mandatory for all divisions - One-way Raceceivers are **mandatory** for the Late Models, Street Stocks, Xtreme Stocks and Legends Cars competing at SSP in 2009. (Optional for Mini Vans, Road Warriors, PENNMAR Vintage Cars.) For more information or to purchase, contact Miller's Racing Parts at 717-766-0181. A limited number of rentals are available on race night. The channel used is 1417 (freq. – 467.7000).
